Walgwan is a treatment center for young people struggling with substance abuse and addictions.

The youths at the Walgwan Center are Aboriginal people between the ages of 12 and 17. They come from Quebec, the Maritimes and sometimes Ontario.

Under the direct supervision of the Team leader, the person will have to meet the following challenges:

- Responsible for the implementation of the clinical/rehabilitation programming and service delivery, involving individual or group programming and activities.
- Provides structure to the youth in assisting them in reaching the objectives as set out in their individualized intervention plan.
- Provides a welcoming environment and assists youth with their integration and orientation into the program.
- Assists in providing treatment counseling to the youth in individual, group, or family therapy as needed
- Enters all required elements of client records into information system in a timely manner
- Participates and assists in organization of cultural and recreational activities

Required qualifications:

- Grade 12 or equivalent AND three (3) years direct work experience as a Residential Educator as a youth caregiver

Or

- Certificate or Diploma in Addictions or Youth care worker AND one (1) year direct work experience as a Residential Educator as a youth caregiver.

Required profile:

- Be in good physical condition
- Adapts easily to changes
- Organized and structured
- Independent, committed, motivated, and outgoing
- Good interpersonal skills and communication skills
- Must submit to a security verification of judicial history, and road safety. Must obtain in the course of the probationary period CPR certificate and non-violent crisis intervention certificate.
- First Nations descent is considered an asset
- Bilingual (or a good understanding of French)

Place of work: Gesgapegiag, Gaspésie, Quebec.

Salary: Depending on experience and qualifications, an annual salary between \$41,158 to \$49,188.

Working conditions: Full time. Probationary period of 6 months. Group insurance, pension plan, personal days and a generous number of annual holidays.
